In addition to the information requested above, you must do the following:

- 1. Write an essay of between 150 and 200 words on why you would like to attend the Institute.
- 2. Submit a **list** of your activities in the area of journalism and writing, including your experience in editing, reporting, and writing news stories, editorials, and feature material (whether for the print, online or broadcast media), and any related experience or activities. (In addition, we **strongly encourage** you to submit three samples of your work in journalism.)
- 3. Ask your guidance counselor to send us the following items:
 - A transcript of your high school record including mid-year grades from current academic year;
 - · Your grade-point average and, if available, class rank;
 - Standardized test scores, if available (PSAT, SAT, or ACT);
 - · A school profile.

(You should give your guidance counselor a stamped envelope addressed to us for use in sending the material. If your counselor cannot provide test scores, you can send them with your application. The Institute does not accept application materials by email or fax.)

- 4. Ask your journalism teacher, newspaper adviser or English teacher to send us a letter of recommendation that gives us an estimate of your talents or abilities in journalism and writing as well as your personal characteristics. Your teacher could send the letter by U.S. mail to the address below or email the letter to **r-boye@northwestern.edu**. (You should give your teacher a stamped envelope if using U.S. mail.)
- 5. Enclose a \$50 check (in U.S. dollars drawn on a U.S. bank) made payable to Northwestern University for the non-refundable application fee.
